What should you prepare in your workshop presentation?

Here is the list of feedback elements to prepare when it is your turn to present:

1. Presenting brief background information: Give brief information about yourself, your thesis, and the research area you had received feedback on.
2. Understanding the received feedback: Clarify the feedback received.
3. Identifying key issues: locate the areas that need improvement.
4. Prioritizing feedback: Determine which feedback to address first.
5. Analyzing feedback: Break down complex feedback into manageable parts.
6. Creating an action plan: State the plan that will use to address each piece of feedback.
7. Implementing changes: State the perceived revisions or modifications you will make.
8. Seeking comments and insights: Request further feedback or guidance if needed.

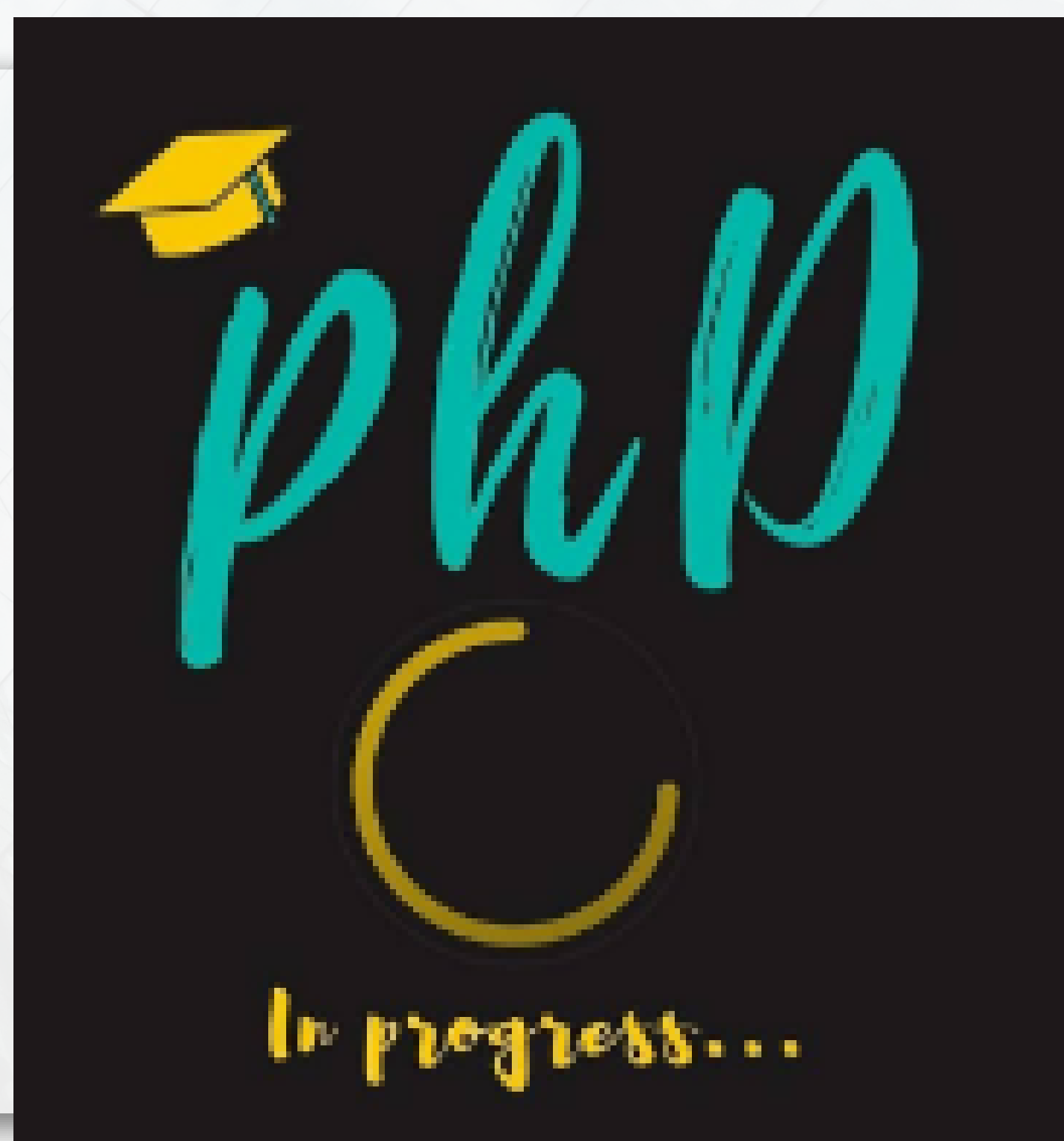
